Dr. Jonathan Jackson is a cognitive neuroscientist who investigates the behavioral, genetic, neurological, physiological, and cognitive changes of normal aging as well as in individuals with Alzheimer's disease. He has a particular interest in topics such as attentional control, episodic memory, the brain's connectivity, subjective concerns, and health disparities. He received his PhD in Psychological and Brain Sciences from Washington University in St. Louis and is now an Instructor in Neurology with Harvard Medical School at Massachusetts General Hospital. When not in the lab, Dr. Jackson speaks about clinical trials, health disparities, and Alzheimer's disease.
